### Email Privacy

Your email address will only be used for communication purposes. The Foundation does not sell, rent or provide email addresses to anyone outside the organization. ### Use of IP addresses and Browser Cookies

A unique number called an IP address identifies every computer on the Internet. When you connect to the Internet an IP address is assigned to your machine. An IP address is a number that identifies each sender or receiver of information that is sent in packets across the Internet. The Foundation does not track your IP address.
